

CHILD FIND NOTICE

Scholar Academy's Special Education Department attempts to identify all students with disabilities who are currently enrolled at the school.

If a student is having significant difficulty with vision, hearing, speech and/or behavior or is experiencing slow development atypical for his/her age, physical impairments or learning difficulty then he/she may be a student with a disability. Disabilities that could interfere with education include: autism, deaf-blindness, deafness, emotional disturbance, hearing impairment, intellectual disabilities, multiple disabilities, orthopedic impairment, specific learning disabilities, communication disorders, traumatic brain injury and visual impairment. Federal law mandates the provision of free, appropriate educational programs and/or services for such persons.
