Message from Director Shepard

New Scholar Discipline Plan follows state legislation on student conduct

We ask Scholar parents to support the School Discipline Plan by:

- Exemplify an enthusiastic and supportive attitude toward school and education.
- Building a good working relationship between themselves and their child, his/her teachers, and the school.
- Teaching their child self-respect, respect for the law, respect for others, and respect for public property.
- Insisting on prompt and regular attendance.
- Listening to views and observations of all parties concerned when responding to a behavior issue with their child
- Recognizing that teachers deserve the same consideration and respect that parents expect from their children.
- Encouraging their child to take pride in his/her appearance and to follow the dress code
- Insisting that their child promptly take home all communications from school.
- Cooperating with the school, jointly resolving any school related problems.
- Setting realistic standards of behavior for their child and be firm, fair, and consistent in applying them.
- Helping their child learn to deal effectively with negative peer pressures.
- Providing a place conducive for study and completion of homework assignments.
- Teaching common courtesies by example.
