### **Carpool Information:**



<u>Click to view video</u> to see how to drop off and pick-up your students at Scholar Academy. You may drop off each morning after 7:45 a.m. if they are eating school breakfast. The library and gym open for early morning play and reading beginning at 8:00 a.m. daily. We like to see our students here bright and early. We want every student prepared and in their seats ready to learn by 8:30 a.m. each morning.

Drop Off occurs in the front of the building ONLY. Pick-up occurs in the back lot and in the front lot. AM Kindergarten pick-up occurs by driving through the front drive-through lane and picking up students outside the front main door.

A limited number of cars are allowed to use the drive through lane at the back of the school, so if you would like to pick up your students in the back lot and carpool with students who are in 3rd through 6th grade (no kindergarten first or second grade students please), you may pick up a pass in the office.

REMINDER: Please do not park in assigned teacher stalls on the West lot (facing the street). Guests and parents park in the South lot.


